2. **Background/Overview of Project/Program/ Venture/Institution/Others**

Uncorrected refractive errors affect persons of all ages and ethnic groups, are the main cause of vision impairment. Refractive errors affect a large proportion of the population worldwide, irrespective of age, sex and ethnic group and are the main cause of vision impairment. They may result in dropping out from education, deprived of employment opportunities, lower productivity and impaired quality of life. Such refractive errors can be easily diagnosed, measured and corrected with spectacles or other refractive corrections to attain normal vision. According to Bangladesh Blindness Profile over 6 million need vision correction by spectacles or other means. But unfortunately, most of the people are unaware about their visual problem and also there are inadequate physicians and optical stores to address these problems. Specialized Ophthalmologist are only available at district levels and also same with the spectacle dispensing stores. Furthermore these peoples cannot afford to spend a day's travel to the nearest district towns and buy a pair of mainstream spectacles.

Misconception and social taboos regarding use of spectacles is another problem. Simple optometry does not need specialized ophthalmologists. Also the scenario in Bangladesh is that the untrained spectacle shop keepers serve to correct the refractive errors which is often full of technical errors. This project, through the trained Opticians, will serve the underserved community in a methodical and correct way.

Bangladesh has huge population suffering from uncorrected refractive errors. In rural Bangladesh, due to lack of awareness about visual impairment and lack of adequate eye care services, a good number of people suffer from uncorrected refractive errors. In most situations, one can expect about 20 per cent of the population in total to require refraction services. TMC&RCH will have a big enough potential market to make it economically viable. Lack of trained ophthalmologists is a major factor for lack of these services. The project offers a unique solution by developing skilled refractionist in large number 400 who can screen and dispense spectacles even at rural setting and thus solving the problems of uncorrected refractive errors. Local youths once trained can set up independent optical service centers and serve local population finding way to solve the unemployment problem as well.

People of Bangladesh are usually oblivious to and unaware of the need for eye care. Most of the time, people don't visit an eye physician until they face serious difficulties or appearance of other visual symptoms. Consequently, the incidence of cataract and blindness cases is on the rise throughout Bangladesh.

Eye care service facilities in Northern Bangladesh are not adequately developed. Present capacity is not enough to serve the newly developed annual cataract patients let alone to deal with the backlog. The patients needing sub-specialty services, such as for cornea, retina, and glaucoma are to be referred to hospitals in the capital, Dhaka that very few patients can afford. As a result, the patients are under served or face economic disaster to bear the huge cost of treatment. Considering the scenario, Rotary Club of Ramna, has come forward and initiated a new global grant project in January, 2019 to establish TMC Jahanara & Jillur Eye Center at 750 Bedded TMSS Medical College and Rafatullah Community Hospital (TMC&RCH), Thengamara, Bogura in order to introduce a well developed eye disease treatment facility to serve a population of nearly 4 million only in Bogura district, Northern part of Bangladesh.

The eye care centre is well-equipped with advanced eye treatment equipment, well trained health professionals and ways to effectively reach the outreach communities of the targeted area. The project has also created mass awareness on eye care among people of project areas, prevented & reduced incidence of cataract/blindness in the project communities, ensured availability of upgraded eye services for cornea, glaucoma and retina (including Diabetic Retinopathy) in the local TMSS Medical College and Rafatullah Community Hospital (TMC&RCH) and contributed to the eye care related health services as stipulated in the national and global plan (SDG). The TMSS hospital authorities decided to commemorate the center in memory of the late parents of AKS contributor Rtn. Cardiovascular Disease (CVD) is the leading cause of death in the world. It takes the lives of 17.9 million people every year, 31% of all global deaths with 80% occurring in low- and middle-income countries. Cardiovascular Disease is also emerging as a serious health problem in Bangladesh. In 2014, Non Communicable Diseases represented 59% of the total deaths; CVD was the single-most important contributor, being responsible for 17% of the country's deaths. Amongst the heart diseases hypertension, rheumatic fever, rheumatic heart disease, ischemic heart diseases and congenital heart diseases are common. A large number of population lives in rural areas of our country suffer from various types of cardiovascular diseases and can't get good quality health care services at an affordable price due to poverty, illiteracy, disadvantageous situation. On the other hand, Road Traffic Accidents (RTA) is a 'global tragedy' with ever-rising trends in fatalities and injuries in the developing countries. It's also become a great medical and social concern in Bangladesh and the situation is deteriorating. A recent study by Accident Research Institute (ARI) at Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology (BUET) revealed that road accidents claim the lives of 12,000 people on an average annually and leave a further 35,000 injured (ARI, 2011). The Economic cost is 2 to 3% of the country's GDP, an enormous loss in health related cost (WHO, 2015). The related health care services for both are much more unavailable in northern region of Bangladesh which is comparatively less developed than other parts of the country. The ascertained consequence is that a large number of patients with cardiovascular diseases and Road Traffic Injuries deprives from required medical services & quality treatments. To deal with the situation, TMSS has decided to strengthen the capacity of Coronary Care and Trauma Services in 750 Bedded TMSS Medical College and Rafatullah Community Hospital, Bogura through the financial/grant assistance of the Embassy of Japan. To materialize the long cherished dream of TMSS in providing good quality healthcare services to the targeted critical patients a project titled "The Project for Installation of Medical Equipment to Strengthen the Capacity of Coronary and Trauma Services Bogura District" was signed on March 31, 2020 between TMSS Medical College & Rafatullah Community Hospital, Bogura and the Embassy of Japan in Bangladesh.
